Novena to The Sacred Heart: 15th - 23rd June (Feast Day). O Divine Jesus who said "Ask and you shall receive, seek and you shall find, knock and the door shall be opened to you. I kneel at your feet. From whom shall I ask if not from you, whose Heart is the source of all blessings. O Divine Jesus, your Heart was moved by compassion for the men and women who came to you in need. Today's Gospel: The feast today highlights the central place of the Eucharist in Christian life, our faith that God becomes present in a real way in ordinary bread and wine – food for the journey of life in the bread, energy and joy for the journey of life in the wine. Each time we come to Mass, the sacrifice of Christ on the cross and his resurrection is made present among us. It is a place and time of grace. So our Eucharist today is not just to commemorate something that happened many years ago. It is our commitment to Christ in his people, and our faith in his real presence among us in the Eucharist and in each other. Jesus ask us o share the bread and cup, to proclaim this 'mystery of faith' for all time, We proclaim today that the Jesus of the tabernacle is the Jesus within all of us. Let's be amazed that within each of us, God dwells in Jesus Christ.
