**Month of the Sacred Heart:** The month of June is devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and this devotion has been practised in the Church for centuries. It would be good to continue our Irish custom of having a picture of the Sacred Heart hanging in our homes with a perpetual light. When Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1670 he gave twelve promises to those devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus which are: **1.** I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life. **2.** I will establish peace in their families. **3.** I will console them in all their troubles. **4.** They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death. **5.** I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings. **6.** Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy. **7.** Tepid souls shall become fervent. **8.** Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection. **9.** I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honoured. **10.** I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts. **11.** Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced. **12.** The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; My heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.

**Today's Gospel:** Our name is important to us and it is nice to have good things associated with it; good, friendly, kind. It is not pleasant to have a 'bad name.' When someone's 'good name' is taken, it is very serious. Our name, however, is not the most important thing. We might never be known by name, our names may never appear on a top 10 list, but the way we live and what we do will ensure we are noticed. In this Year of Mercy, each of us can play the part of the woman in the Gospel. The life of a stranger, or even a friend or loved one can be changed forever by an anonymous act of kindness done in secret for the love of Jesus. After all, the least we do to others, we do to Christ.
